What we do and how we make a difference


We provide therapy to people of all ages with very diverse needs including physical and learning disabilities, autism, anxiety and dementia.

Equine assisted learning

Equine Assisted Learning offers the opportunity to spend quality time with horses in ways other than riding. These sessions aim to give you the space you need to experience and develop a relationship with a horse more fully.





Riding lessons

Our instructors are fully qualified and experienced with riders of all abilities. We can accommodate riders according to their specific needs in a safe environment. We cater for riders, both children and adults, with physical disabilities or learning difficulties.

Tea with a pony

An opportunity to spend time in a relaxed atmosphere with our gentle ponies and enjoy tea and cake with our friendly volunteers.
